This systems works with ANY weapon they have on their belt and secures inside a holster. For standing front, side and rear attacks, to include the SAME technique when on the ground.

The techniques and tactics that are presented in this program are field proven. This course concentrates on use of anatomically correct techniques that allow for the natural movement of limbs without twisting and bending for control, providing the officer with various force options, disengagement techniques and the ability to retain their firearm without losing control.
